

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR HUMBLESCOUGH FARM CARAVAN SITE



- A non-refundable £20 deposit is required to secure bookings (payable by cheque or bank transfer – please ask for account details.) For stays of 4 days or more, and for bank holidays, we ask for a £30 deposit.
- Payment on the site can be made by cheque, cash or bank transfer. Cheques payable to R & DL Cornthwaite. Deposits can be paid by bank transfer or cheque.
- There is a minimum booking of 2 nights at weekends and 3 nights for bank holiday weekends.
- The maximum number of persons allowed per pitch is 6
- Strictly no noise after 11.00pm (music should be played at a reasonable level and stopped by 10.00pm.)
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and cleaned up after. They should be exercised off the site. We do not accept any breed of dog listed under the dangerous dog act.
- Arrival times are after 1pm. Pitches should be vacated by 12 noon on the day of departure. (Later departure time are sometimes available. The charge is £1 per extra hour.)
- No Chinese Lanterns or drones are to be set off on site.
- Camp fires are allowed provided that a fire pit is used and wood is purchased from the farm. For health & safety reasons please do not bring your own firewood, also do not collect wood from our woodland and hedgerows because they provide habitat for a wide variety of wildlife.

Just a couple of points to remember about camp fires:

1. Keep the camp fires at least 2 metres from any tent

2. Don't forget that ashes and embers might still be hot in the morning

- Barbecues are permitted but must be elevated off the grass.
- Please inform us before the arrival of visitors. An extra payment of £5 per car will be charged for anyone staying for any period of time in excess of 60 minutes.
- At Humblescough Farm we try to be as environmentally friendly as possible. Please recycle all glass bottles & jars, plastic bottles, cans, tins, cardboard & paper. Bins are provided for this.
- Children under 16 must be kept under supervision at all times and parents must be aware that this is a working farm with farm machinery.

Vehicle drivers, motorcyclists and cyclists are required to adhere to the 5mph speed limit on site
